Organise some simple fundraising activities this Christmas and **help us beat cancer**. Here are twelve ideas to get you started!

1 Snowman Drive

Rather than a traditional Beetle Drive, why not try a Snowman Drive instead? It's an easy activity that the whole family can take part in. Ask your Cancer Research UK contact for special Snowman Drive score cards designs you can print at home.

2 Carol Concert


Join together with your local choir, musicians and singers to host your very own Christmas Carol Concert. Why not add in some mince pies, mulled wine and Christmas craft stalls too.

3 Santa's Christmas Quiz

Dust off your Santa hat and host a winter quiz this Christmas. Ask for a donation to take part and hold a raffle too full of Christmas gifts!

4 Festive Collections

Plan a festive themed collection by asking a local choir to sing with you while you collect, ask a band to play Christmas songs or go to town in Christmas fancy dress and see how much more money you raise than your usual collection!



5 Christmas Card Pop-up Shop

Get in touch with local Christmas fayres, fetes and other community events and ask if you can set up a pop-up shop to sell CRUK Christmas cards and badges.

6 Santa's Little Helpers

Ask for adult volunteers to become little helpers and arrange an auction. Get people to bid for their little helper and the winning bidders will get an 'elfing' hand for the day! It could be tea making, filing or even decorating your Christmas tree for you.

7 Winter Wrapping Service

Get together a team of gift wrapping elves and give your friends and family a night off from wrapping in return for a donation.



8 Secret CRUK Santa

Rather than exchanging the typical Secret Santa gifts with your friends and family this Christmas (because who needs another turkey hat?!) make a donation and instead do something thoughtful for each other.

9 Festive Bake Off

Mince pies, gingerbread or a Christmas yule log...put your festive baking skills to the test! Donate to enter, win a prize for the person crowned Christmas Cake Champion. After the judging has taken place, auction off or sell your festive bakes.

10 Guess the Little Angel

A fun party game or one for the workplace – ask everyone to bring a photo in of themselves as a child and ask for donations to guess which little angel is which.

11 Christmas Hamper

Ask people to contribute items to make up a scrumptious Christmas hamper. Organise a competition to decide who will get to take the hamper home to enjoy, asking people to donate to take part.



12 Breakfast with Santa

Organise a breakfast with Santa at your local school or community centre. Ask for a donation for entry to include a selection box for the children and the chance for parents to take a photo of their children with Santa using their own camera or phone.
